Is the USA Rx card easy to use?

Yes! Just present the card along with your prescription at one of the 60,000 participating pharmacies that accept our card. The card gives you immediate discounts on your prescription medications.

How much of a discount will I receive?

The card offers discounts from 10% to 75% off most prescription medications.

Is the USA Rx card insurance?

No, the card is not medical insurance. The USA Rx program simply provides you with a discounted price on prescription drugs.

Will The USA Rx card work with my insurance?

If you have insurance, you should bring both your insurance and USA Rx Card to your pharmacist and ask which gives you the better discount. Our program is not designed to add additional discounts to the price you are already receiving from your insurance carrier. However, many cardholders find lower prices using the USA Rx card instead of using their high deductible, high co-pay or HSA insurance plans.

How much does the USA Rx card cost? How do I qualify?

The card is absolutely FREE and anyone qualifies. Simply bring your pre-activated card with you on your next visit to the pharmacy and start saving money on your medications today.

Frequently Asked Questions

Does the card work on brand and generic medications?

Yes, the USA Rx card provides discounts on both brand and generic medications.

Do I need to sign up to use the card?

The card is pre-activated and ready for immediate use. No registration or forms to fill out.

Do I have to bring the card to my pharmacy each time to get my discount?

The first time you use the card, the pharmacist will save your card information on file. Each visit after that initial visit to that pharmacy chain, your savings will automatically be deducted! You just need to bring your card with you any time you go to a new pharmacy.

Do I need to get a different card for each member of my family?

You can use one card to save for your entire family.

Does the card cover medications for pre-existing conditions?

Absolutely! Everyone can use the card.

Is my medical information private?

We comply with HIPAA regulations. USA Rx will never share your personal or medical information with a third party.

Will my card expire?

No, your card will not expire.

Can anyone use my card?

Yes - family, friends, co-workers, or anyone who can use this type of prescription assistance!

I am not a U.S. Citizen, can I use the card?

Absolutely, anyone may use the USA Rx card if it is used at pharmacies within the U.S.

Will the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act affect the USA Rx card?

The USA Rx savings card will operate in the exact same fashion under the ACA. The pre-activated status, the discounts, and the availability nationwide will all stay the same.
